This was our first year as LNT Leads! We had 46 LNT Volunteers this year – including ~20 for the Monday MOOP Sweep. Our overall goal was to increase LNT presence and awareness onsite and prior to the festival. We created new roles, created LNT messaging and reached out to all BitF leads, theme camps and art installations.

New initiatives this year

- Educational MOOP Scroll at the gate and 10 LNT painted signs around the site (Thanks to Maria Bedia)
- Recruited volunteers at Recharge
- Created a six page LNT Guide
- Created MOOP Ambassador roles / with LNT Capes for visual identity (Thanks to Niki from Action Faction)
- Creating messaging for MOOP Ambassadors
- Staged MOOP Dramas
- Created an LNT Binder for Volunteer HQ
- Created a theme camp/art placement outreach volunteer position
- Created *LNT Volunteer Roles and Duties* document
- Received a microgrant to hand out Pocket Ashtrays
- Did a “live MOOP sort” at the Volunteer Appreciation Party / Photo documentation for report
- Created a Monday MOOP Sweep tradition with group singing: “MOOP There It Is!”
- Drew a MOOP map of General Camping
- Clarified issues around Grey Water rules in the LNT Guide and in Facebook discussions
- Invited theme camps to “Adopt a PortaPotty”
- Instructions and baggies for hygiene products in porta potties

Recommendations from 2016 that we implemented in 2017

1. Organic Waste is MOOP

Last year's LNT team found a lot of organic waste MOOP, so this year we included "organic waste is MOOP" messaging on a social media post about MOOP and on the LNT MOOP Scroll.

2. Portapotty baggies

2016 recommendation: "provide "ziploc bags in the porta-potties for menstruating folk to pack their used tampons, pads, and applicators with them." After some community discussion on Facebook we decided to supply small paper bags, stored in a protective Ziploc bag in the majority of portapotties.

3. MOOP Sweep Teams

2016 recommendation: two teams of eight people do the Monday MOOP Sweep for 4 hours. We had one large team of over 20 people people for 4 hours (including a lunch break) and that worked well! We were able to sweep almost all theme camps, the general camping area, art placement areas, centre camp and the beach, with the exception of those still packing up.



MOOP Sweep of General Camping

Monday MOOP Sweep Overview

- One large team of over 20 people
- Five people signed up for the sweep day off!
- 4 hours with a lunch break
- We ordered a 'party Sub' and cookie tray with juice and granola bars to feed the crew
- We were unable to sweep Monkey Camp, Puck's Palace, or Dante's Inferno as they were still onsite
- The grossest MOOP award goes to Monkey Camp where we cleaned up vomit and a used condom
- We created a MOOP map of General Camping
- Lots of MOOP looked old
- All collected MOOP was photo documented

Issues Identified in the 2016 LNT Report that continued to be issues in 2017

- Many art projects and theme camps did not leave on Sunday (about 10 or so)
- Placement markers not left in place for Monday MOOP Sweep
- Some picnic tables were not put back in their original place
- Hard to MOOP Sweep with camps still packing up on Monday
- We are below a 50% sign out rate

“We need to work with the community to come up with a system where the camps load out before we do our sweep” –LNT Report 2016

2018 Goals

- Increase theme camp and art installation coordination pre-festival, focusing on sign out and LNT plans
- Increase coordination with placement, focusing on markers
- Fine tune volunteer roles and times
- Encourage more porta potty adoptions
- Encourage more Moop Dramas
- Create additional roles to take load off of the leads - especially a Sunday Sign Out Lead
- Create an engagement art piece from the collected MOOP

Recommendations for next year

- A table left at Vol HQ with clear LNT signage for Sunday sign out
- We need four Sunday sign out people on each shift instead of two
- We need access to two gators and three radios to expedite the Sunday sign out process
- People with radios on Sunday should wear fluorescent shirts so people can easily flag them down when ready for sign out
- Aim to get more volunteers than necessary as there are inevitable no shows
- Schedule MOOP Ambassador shifts on Friday during the day – not on Saturday when people want to party
- Decentralize the MOOP dramas and stage them when it is not super hot
- Continue with social media posts and education pre-event to reduce MOOP
- MOOP picker uppers: a bunch of them broke – we will need more next year
- Half the MOOP Sweep team were our friends – we still need to encourage more people to stay to help
- More support for LNT on Sunday and Monday: staying on Sunday to sign people out and on Monday to clean up other people's MOOP are not the most appealing volunteer positions. We need to make it easier for people to say 'yes' to these roles. For future, consider extending commissary hours to be able to feed LNT volunteer on Sunday and Monday.
